





Oren Jacobson is the co-founder and CEO of <u>Project Shema</u>, which trains and supports the Jewish community and allies to more effectively address contemporary antisemitism with an emphasis on how anti-Jewish ideas show up in discourse around Israel and Palestine.

Oren is a nationally recognized expert on this issue and, through this work, he has advised major Jewish institutions and served as a subject matter expert on antisemitism to multinational corporations and institutions for higher learning.

In 2015, Oren founded Men4Choice, a multi-state advocacy organization working to bring male allies into the fight for reproductive freedom. Men4Choice is the only organization of its kind in the country and is now starting to work with organizers outside the U.S as they seek to replicate the organization's strategy and impact.

He's also the former National Chapter Development Director for the New Leaders Council, where he helped grow NLC into the largest leadership development organization in the progressive movement. He holds a Master's in International Relations from the University of Chicago, a Master's in Economics and Policy Analysis from DePaul University, and a Master's in Business Administration from Regis University.
