Adam Neuman serves as Chief of Staff and Special Advisor to the President of the Baltimore Ravens, where he provides strategic counsel and manages the administrative, operational, financial, and legal activities for President Sashi Brown. Neuman plays an instrumental role in driving organization-wide strategic initiatives and aligning the team's football operations with corporate strategy, with his work touching nearly every area of the business.

Previously, Neuman served as Chief of Staff, Strategy and Operations, and Deputy General Counsel for the Big Ten Conference. Before his time at the Big Ten, Neuman worked as a corporate associate at Simpson Thacher & Bartlett LLP in their capital markets division. His career also includes serving as the lead speechwriter for the President of Yeshiva University, Richard M. Joel.

Neuman has been recognized for his leadership and influence, including being named to The Athletic's (New York Times) inaugural College Sports 40 Under 40 at just 32 years of age for his noteworthy role amid the stunning additions UCLA, USC, Oregon, and Washington and the league's \$8-Billion-Dollar record-breaking media rights deal. His peers describe him as a dynamic leader with a rare blend of legal acumen, strategic vision, and unrelenting work ethic.

In 2024, Neuman was appointed by Maryland Governor Wes Moore to the Maryland Port Commission, where he contributes to the future development of the Port of Baltimore, one of the nation's largest and most vital ports. Neuman is a member of professional organizations including the Sports Lawyers Association and Owings Mills Corporate Roundtable and serves on the Board of Advisors for Israel Baseball Americas and Boost, an analytics and generative AI company transforming data and content into commerce. Neuman also teaches a Master's level course in Intercollegiate Athletic Administration at Columbia University.

Neuman earned his undergraduate degree from Yeshiva University, a Juris Doctor from the University of Pennsylvania Law School, and a Master's in Public Administration from the Fels

Institute of Government at the University of Pennsylvania. He also holds a certificate in Sport Social Work from the University of Michigan and a certificate in Business Management from the Wharton School.
